

Your teacher will provide you information about the learning to complete at home through the Seesaw Class app.
Follow the steps below each day.

1	Check <b>Seesaw</b> for what tasks your teacher has set you for today. You will receive a weekly or daily <b>ConectEd@GGS</b> learning guide that provides an overview of learning activities.
2	Complete the <b>set activities</b> on Seesaw.
3	Check through your <b>journal</b> as your teacher may have given feedback for activities previously completed.
4	Check your <b>specialist classes</b> on Seesaw for other tasks that may be set throughout the week.
5	Consolidate your learning and practise your skills through your <b>online subscriptions</b> .
6	Spend time being <b>active outside</b> .

If you are unsure about what you should be working on at home or how to access your lessons and tasks, please email your class teacher.

## **Accessing Seesaw**

**Each student has a unique Home Learning Code to access Seesaw**. When signing in with their Home Learning Code, students only see their own work, activities assigned to them and announcements sent to students by teachers. Students do not see the work of any other student in the class.

## **How Do Students Use Their Home Learning Code?**

- 1. Students go to <a href="https://app.seesaw.me">https://app.seesaw.me</a> on a computer in Chrome or Firefox browser. Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS and Android device. This is different to the Family App that you currently use as a parent.
- 2. Students tap "I'm a Student".
- 3. Students scan their code using Seesaw's built-in QR code reader or type in their text code to access their Seesaw account.
