Fees:

The cost is \$65 per day per child for fixed bookings, \$68 per day per child for casual bookings - less with your Child Care Subsidy (if eligible).

An additional \$25.00 will be charged on outing days and incursion days.

Hours:

- The Centre opening times are from 7.00am till 6.00pm.
- Excursions depart on time and will not be held over (this is due to venue bookings).

Program changes:

- Program changes may occur, without notice, due to hot or inclement weather.
- We cannot take responsibility if an event is changed by a third-party provider.

Note:

- Bookings for the Centre are a firm commitment and as such incur a charge for service (on excursion and incursion days the activity cost will also be charged).
- There is a requirement to give a minimum of 24 hours notice of a non-attendance or in the case of sickness as soon as practically possible.
- A non-attendance/late cancellation charge applies for non-attendance or cancellation within 24 hours APART from excursion/incursion days where a period of 1 week (7 days) applies.
- If notification is not received 24 hours before the commencement of the day concerned there will then be a charge plus the excursion/incursion charge if on such a day.
